# School Award

This Award is available to each High School in the Orange Local Government Area and recognises students who have an understanding of conservation, preservation and education of heritage in Australia including the Orange area.

The Award is to fit into the school curriculum, i.e. Drama, Visual Art, English or History Writing, Science and Photography and may be presented in a variety of formats including short film (maximum of 15 minutes in length), diorama, model, debate, essay or report and may comprise oral history or research on a heritage building, place, object or theme relating to Orange and district.

**Winning entries will receive a \$100.00 cheque from Orange City Council.**

## Guidelines

- Each School is to select the winning entry and forward the name and address of the student to Council's Museum and Heritage Coordinator.
- Each school must request the prize at least 2 weeks prior to its annual presentation or related event to allow for administration.
- Winning entries will receive a \$100 cheque from Orange City Council to be presented at the Schools annual presentation/ awards evening.
- All entries are to be available for publication by Orange City Council. Winners will be notified in writing and may be published in the *Central Western Daily* and or on Council's website.
